Answer: The four means of transport are as follows:

1. Roadways
2. Railways
3. Waterways
4. Airways

(ii) What do you understand by the term 'settlement'?

Answer: Settlements are places where human beings built their homes. Earlier human beings lived in forests and in caves but with time and advancement in vegetation, humans made homes to create settlements.

(iii) Which are the activities practised by the rural people?
