Question 1:

Why was there great joy in Nina's house?

Answer:

There was great joy in Nina's house because Nina's aunt was getting married, and all of her family members were going to attend the wedding in Delhi.

Question 2:

Why was Nina worried?

Answer:

Nina was worried because there were two baby sparrows in the nest in her room. If all the family members left and locked the house, the papa and mama sparrows would not be able to feed the baby sparrows.

Question 3:

What did mother suggest?

Answer:

Mother suggested that they will remove everything from Nina's room and lock the room from the outside. They will keep the window of Nina's room open so that the papa and mama sparrows can come and feed the baby sparrows.

Question 4:

What did Nina find when she came back from the wedding?

Answer

When Nina came back from the wedding, she saw two plump little sparrows flying all over the room.

I would also like to wear a beautiful white top and a green trouser.


